God ... commands all people everywhere to REPENT. (Acts 17:30)

... turn to God in repentance and have faith in our Lord Jesus. (Acts 20:21)

...repent and turn to God and prove [your] repentance by [your] deeds. (Acts 26:20)

REPENT, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord, (Acts 3:19)

...unless you repent, you too will all perish. (Luke 13:3)

...I am in AGONY in this fire. (Luke 16:24) // ...I have five brothers. Let him WARN them, so that they will not also come to THIS PLACE OF TORMENT.' (Luke 16:28)

Or do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived; neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor homosexuals, nor thieves, nor the covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers, will inherit the kingdom of God. Such were some of you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the Spirit of our God. (1 Cor. 6:9-11)

But the cowardly, the unbelieving, the vile, the murderers, the sexually immoral, those who practice magic arts, the idolaters and all liars - their place will be in the fiery lake of burning sulfur. This is the second death. (Rev 21:8)

Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry. Because of these, the wrath of God is coming. You used to walk in these ways, in the life you once lived. **But now you must rid yourselves of all such things as these:** anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips. Do not lie to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator. (Col 3:5-10)

If anyone considers himself religious and yet does not keep a tight rein on his tongue, he deceives himself and his religion is WORTHLESS. (James 1:26)

He went on: "What comes out of a man is what makes him 'unclean.' For from within, out of men's hearts, come evil thoughts, sexual immorality, theft, murder, adultery, greed, malice, deceit, lewdness, envy, slander, arrogance and folly. All these evils come from inside and make a man 'unclean.' (Mark 7:20-23)

Be self-controlled and alert. **Your enemy the devil** prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to **devour**. (1 Pet 5:8)

I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you. (Psa 119:11)

Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away. (Mat 24:35)

People who want to get rich **fall into temptation and a trap** and into many foolish and harmful desires that plunge men into **ruin and destruction**. (1 Tim 6:9)

For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but **against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms**. (Eph 6:12)

For if you forgive men when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins. (Mat 6:14,15)

With many other words he **warned** them; and he pleaded with them, "**Save yourselves from this corrupt generation.**" (Acts 2:40)

If **your hand or your foot** causes you to sin cut it off and throw it away. It is better for you to enter life maimed or crippled than to have two hands or two feet and be thrown into **eternal fire**. (Mat 18:8)

And if **your eye causes you to sin,** gouge it out and throw it away. It is better for you to enter life with one eye than to have two eyes and be **thrown into the fire of hell**. (Mat 18:9)

Jesus said, "If you **hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples**. Then you will **know the truth**, and the truth will set you free." (John 8:31,32)

He replied, "**My mother and brothers** are those who **hear God's word and** <u>**put it into practice**</u>." (Luke 8:21)

Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account. (Heb 4:13)

Someone asked him, "Lord, are only a few people going to be saved?" He said to them, "Make every effort to enter through the narrow door, because many, I tell you, will try to enter and will not be able to. (Luke 13:23,24)

The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. He is patient with you, **not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.** (2 Pet 3:9)

Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to salvation and leaves no regret, but worldly sorrow brings death. (2 Cor 7:10)

He made no distinction between us and them, for he purified their hearts by faith. (Acts 15:9)

Let the wicked forsake his way and the evil man his thoughts. Let him turn to the LORD, and he will have mercy on him, and to our God, for he will freely pardon. (Isa 55:7)

He who conceals his sins does not prosper, but whoever confesses and renounces them finds mercy. (Prov 28:13)

This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ **to all who believe.** There is no difference, (Rom 3:22)

He who is not with me is AGAINST ME, and he who does not gather with me scatters. (Mat 12:30)

If anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was **thrown into the lake of fire.** (Rev 20:15)

Why do you call me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say? (Luke 6:46)

Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says. (James 1:22)

As the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without deeds is dead. (James 2:26)

Jesus said >> "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." (John 8:12)

Now listen, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go to this or that city, spend a year there, carry on business and make money." Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes. Instead, you ought to say, "If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that." (James 4:13-15)

Do not be afraid of what you are about to suffer. I tell you, the devil will put some of you in prison **to test you**, and you will **suffer persecution** for ten days. **Be faithful, even to the point of death,** and I will give you **the crown of life**. He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. **He who overcomes will not be hurt at all by the second death.** (Rev 2:10,11)

The one who sows to please his sinful nature, from that nature **will reap destruction**; the one who sows to please the Spirit, **from the Spirit will reap ETERNAL LIFE.** Let us not become weary **in doing good**, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest **if we do not give up.** (Gal 6:8,9)

I am coming soon. Hold on to what you have, so that no one will take your crown. (Rev 3:11)

You adulterous people, don't you know that **friendship with the world is hatred toward God? Anyone who chooses to be a friend of the world becomes an enemy of God.** (James 4:4)

Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather, **be afraid of the One who can destroy both soul and body in hell.** (Mat 10:28)

All men will hate you because of me, but he who stands firm to the end will be saved. (Mat 10:22)

We have come to share in Christ IF WE HOLD firmly TILL THE END the confidence we had at first. (Heb 3:14)

For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but **to save the world through him**. (John 3:17)

Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." (John 14:6)

Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved." (Acts 4:12)

And he has given him authority to judge because he is the Son of Man. **Do not be amazed at this,** for A TIME IS COMING WHEN ALL WHO ARE IN THEIR GRAVES WILL HEAR HIS VOICE AND **COME OUT - those who have DONE GOOD WILL RISE TO LIVE, and those who have done evil will rise TO BE CONDEMNED.** (John 5:27-29)

Today, if you hear his voice, **do not harden your hearts**... (Heb 3:7,8)

We know that we have come to know him IF WE OBEY HIS COMMANDS. The man who says, "I know him," but does not do what he commands is a liar, and the truth is not in him. (1 John 2:3,4)

Paul discoursed on **righteousness**, **self-control and THE JUDGMENT TO COME**, FELIX WAS **AFRAID**... (Acts 24:25)

God opposes the proud but gives grace TO THE HUMBLE. Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Come near to God and he will come near to you. Wash your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded. Grieve, mourn and wail. Change your laughter to mourning and your joy to gloom. Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up. (James 4:6-10)

In your struggle against sin, you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding your blood. (Heb 12:4)

Blessed are they whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered. **Blessed** is the man whose sin the Lord will never count against him. (Rom 4:7,8)

our old self was crucified with him so that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin - because anyone who has died has been freed from sin. (Rom 6:6,7)

He [Moses] chose to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a short time. He regarded disgrace for the sake of Christ as of greater value than the treasures of Egypt, because he was looking ahead to his reward. (Heb 11:25,26)

do not let anyone lead you astray. He who does what is right is righteous, just as he is righteous. He who does what is sinful is of the devil... (1 John 3:7,8)

The man who **loves his life will lose it**, while the man who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life. (John 12:25)

For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me and for the gospel will save it. (Mark 8:35)

if anyone keeps my word, he will never see death. (John 8:51)

"If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." (John 8:31,32)

Anyone who loves his father or mother more than me **is not worthy of me**; anyone who loves his son or daughter more than me **is not worthy of me**; and anyone who does not take his cross and follow me **is not worthy of me**. (Mat 10:37,38)

Blessed is the man who perseveres under trial, because when he has **stood THE TEST**, he will receive the crown of life that God has promised **to those who love him.** (James 1:12)

Then he said to them all: "If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me." (Luke 9:23)

He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God **does NOT have life.** (1 John 5:12)

...he became the source of eternal salvation for all who OBEY him (Heb 5:9)

do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its evil desires. (Rom 6:12)

Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but **ONLY he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.** (Mat 7:21)

...To him who overcomes, I will give the right to eat from the tree of life, which is in the PARADISE of God. (Rev 2:7)

Then he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." Jesus answered him, "I tell you the truth, today you will be with me in PARADISE." (Luke 23:42,43)

And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Now the dwelling of God is with men, and he will live with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God. He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away." (Rev 21:3,4)

But in keeping with his promise we are looking forward to a new heaven and a new earth, the home of righteousness. So then, dear friends, since you are looking forward to this, **MAKE EVERY EFFORT** to be found **spotless, blameless and at peace with him.** (2 Pet 3:13,14)

Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God. (Mat 5:8)

They overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony; **they did not love their lives so much as to shrink from death.** (Rev 12:11)

The acts of the sinful nature are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God. (Gal 5:19-21)

He also forced everyone, small and great, rich and poor, free and slave, to receive a mark on his right hand or on his forehead, so that no one could buy or sell unless he had the mark, which is the name of the beast or the number of his name. (Rev 13:16,17)

If anyone is to go into **captivity**, into captivity he will go. If anyone is to be **killed with the sword**, with the sword he will be killed. **This calls for patient endurance and faithfulness on the part of the saints.** (Rev 13:10)

A third angel followed them and said in a loud voice: "If anyone worships the beast and his image and receives his mark on the forehead or on the hand, he, too, will drink of the wine of God's fury, which has been poured full strength into the cup of his wrath. **He will be tormented with burning sulfur** in the presence of the holy angels and of the Lamb. And **the smoke of their torment rises for ever and ever. There is no rest day or night** for those who worship the beast and his image, or for anyone who receives the mark of his name." **This calls for patient endurance on the part of the saints who obey God's commandments and remain faithful to Jesus.** (Rev 14:9-12)

What good is it for a man to gain the whole world, yet forfeit his soul? Or what can a man give in exchange for his soul? If anyone is ashamed of me and my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, the Son of Man will be ashamed of him when he comes in his Father's glory with the holy angels. (Mark 8:36-38)

how shall we escape if we ignore such a great salvation?... (Heb 2:3)

Here is a trustworthy saying: If we died with him, we will also live with him; if we endure, we will also reign with him. If we disown him, he will also disown us; if we are faithless, he will remain faithful, for he cannot disown himself. Keep reminding them of these things.... (2 Tim 2:11-14)

If a righteous man turns from his righteousness and does evil, he will DIE for it. And if a wicked man turns away from his wickedness and does what is just and right, he will LIVE by doing so. (Ezek 33:18,19)

Don't you know that when you offer yourselves to some one to obey him as slaves, you are slaves to the one whom you obey--whether you are slaves to sin, which leads to death, or to obedience, which leads to righteousness? But thanks be to God that, though you used to be slaves to sin, you wholeheartedly obeyed the form of teaching to which you were entrusted. You have been set free from sin and have become slaves to righteousness. I put this in human terms because you are weak in your natural selves. Just as you used to offer the parts of your body in slavery to impurity and to ever-increasing wick edness, so now offer them in slavery to righteousness leading to holiness. When you were slaves to sin, you were free from the control of righteousness. What benefit did you reap at that time from the things you are now ashamed of? Those things result in death! But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves to holiness, and the result is eternal life. (Rom 6:16-22)

Every tree that does not bear good fruit is **cut down and thrown into the fire.** (Mat 7:19) You will say then, "Branches were broken off so that I could be grafted in." Granted. But they were **broken off because of unbelief, and you stand by faith. Do not be arrogant, but BE AFRAID.** For **if God did not spare the natural branches, he will not spare you either.** Consider therefore **the kindness and sternness of God:** sternness to those who fell, but kindness to you, **provided that you continue in his kindness. Otherwise, you also will be cut off.** And if they do not persist in unbelief, they will be grafted in, **for God is able to graft them in again.** (Rom 11:19-23)

In a similar way, **SODOM AND GOMORRAH AND THE SURROUNDING TOWNS** gave themselves up to sexual immorality and perversion. They serve as **an example of those who SUFFER the punishment of ETERNAL FIRE.** (Jude 7)

... [God] condemned the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah by burning them to ashes, and **made them an** example of WHAT IS GOING TO HAPPEN TO THE UNGODLY; (2 Pet 2:6)

The Son of Man will send out his angels, and they will weed out of his kingdom everything that causes sin and all who do evil. They will THROW THEM INTO THE FIERY FURNACE, WHERE THERE WILL BE <u>WEEPING AND GNASHING OF TEETH</u>. (Mat 13:41,42)

Enter by the narrow gate. For the gate is wide and the way is EASY that leads to destruction, and those who enter by it are MANY. For the gate is narrow and the way is HARD that leads to life, and those who find it are FEW. (Mt. 7:13,14)

God will give to each person according to what he has done. To those who by **PERSISTENCE IN DOING GOOD** seek glory, honor and immortality, he will give **eternal life.** But for those who are **self-seeking and who reject the truth and follow evil, there will be WRATH AND ANGER.** (Rom 2:6-8)

The one who **believes in the Son has eternal life**; but the one who **does not OBEY** the Son will not see life, but **the wrath of God remains on him.** (Jn. 3:36)
