**You're fighting for your very soul, so that is your mission.**

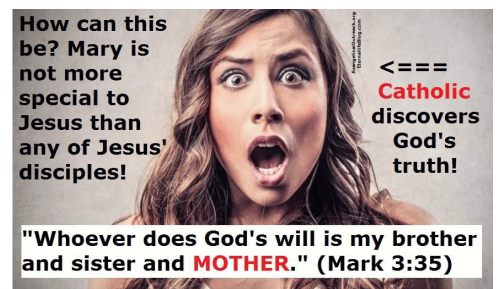
Though your family and priest might get angry and mad,

**Two Marys exist, but one is imaginary -- a product of Tradition.**

**That fabricated Mary has become an *idol* and a sure way to Perdition.**

In Paul's day there was another Jesus -- a mythical, horrible misrepresentation.

**In Catholicism, there exists another Mary, one who has led multitudes to damnation.**

**Become biblically educated and knowledgeable as a safe foundation.**

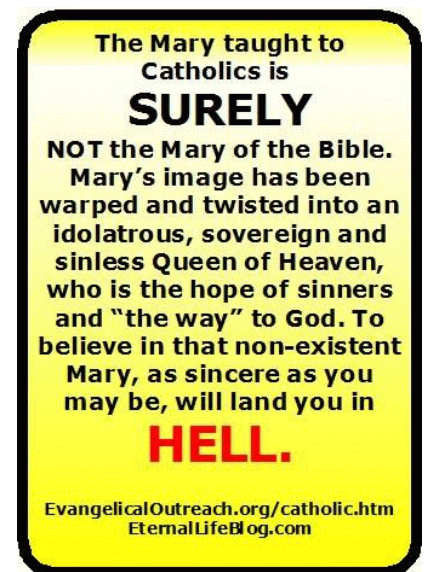
[Mt. 11:11; Ex. 20:5; Hosea 13:2]
