

What Does Roman Catholicism Teach?

The Bible alone is **not** final authority. Sacred Tradition is equal to the Bible and the Bible should be understood as the Pope and other Catholic authorities interpret it. The Bible also includes the Apocrypha.

The one true church established by Jesus Christ is Roman Catholicism, built on Peter the first Pope. The Pope is called the "Vicar of Christ," and speaks infallibly when he speaks ex cathedra.

One is "born again" and becomes a child of God at the point of infant baptism.

our death.

The epitome of the whole gospel is the Rosary, which began around 1090 AD. Mary has given 15 distinct promises regarding the Rosary during the thirteenth century through St. Dominic and Blessed Alan.
