Our 801 page book entitled, The Believer's Conditional Security by Dan Corner cites 18 Biblical examples of the former and multiple Scriptures affirming the latter yet teaches WE ARE SAVED BY GRACE! It also cites, carefully analyzes and Biblically answers 110 of the chief arguments and proof texts used by the proponents of eternal security. Perhaps most importantly, the 24 safeguards will help assure that YOU will not be like the 5 foolish virgins who were not ready to meet the Lord when He arrived (Matt. 25:1-13).

Our books will help you consider a position regarding this subject which is seldom communicated, but which is clearly taught in Scripture—a CONDITIONAL security for the believer in Christ.


